

# St David's Day Activity time!



I'm so excited about St David's Day I decided to make a Daffodil picture for my little dragon friend! Why don't you give it a go?

## For the Parents

1. First, tear the 'cup' parts off the egg carton. Tear the edges roughly by hand so they look like natural ruffles.
2. Paint the torn egg cartons yellow.  
Tip: either paint the center with orange or you can do as I did and paint popcorn yellow for the center. You don't have to use popcorn you could use scrunched up tissue paper
3. Print our template (overleaf) onto yellow or white paper and cut out.
4. Stick the egg cartons onto the middle of the petal.
5. Glue the petals onto a piece of paper and using green paint / crayons/felts draw the daffodil stems and grass.  
Alternatively - roll up a piece of green paper and yellow tape to make a stem. Then pin the petal and egg carton to the stem.

## You will need:

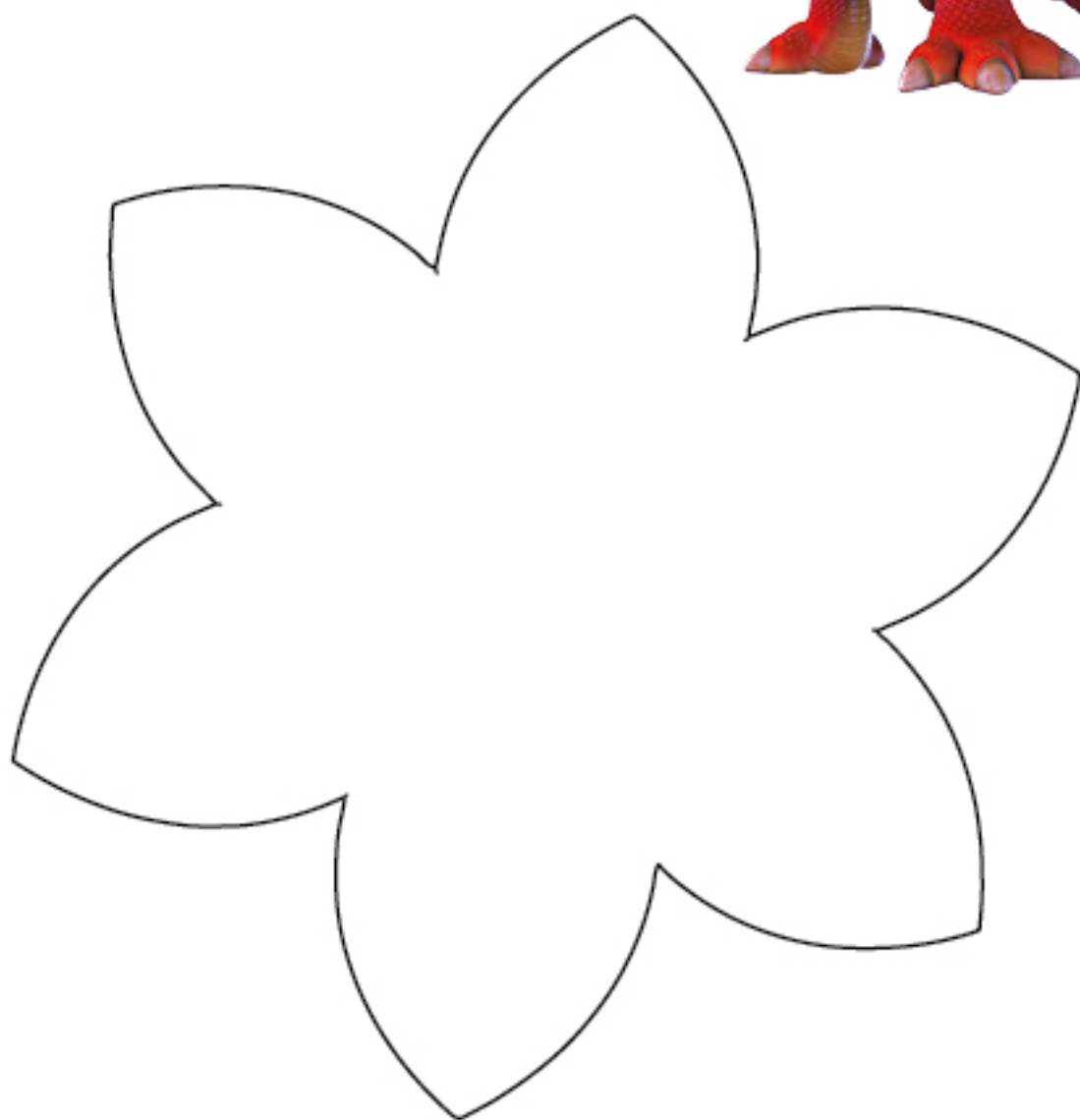
An egg box,  
Yellow paint,  
Green paint or felts/crayons  
Glue,  
Tape,  
Green and yellow (or white for petals) paper  
Printer (or you could draw the petal shape)
